The theme of this year's event is "The Healing Journey Continues Through Truth and Reconciliation". This collaborative community event is hosted by Katzie First Nations, Fraser River Indigenous Society, PLEA Community Services and BC SPOKES. We are partnering with over 30 other local organizations and nonprofits to plan and organize an inclusive and safe community event that supports learning about and supporting Truth and Reconciliation.

The focus of this year's event is "**Healing Through Drumming**". Activities include performances by Indigenous drum groups and performers, special guest speakers, a variety of onsite vendors, orange shirt painting, the creation of a community art project, supporting drum circles, sharing information about supports in the community and creating a safe place for those impacted by the residential school system to come together and share and witness through stories.

This year, we are expecting to welcome over 3,000 people and we are inviting local artists and artisans to join the celebration by hosting a booth, selling hand-made art and other items and supporting the healing journey towards Truth and Reconciliation that we are all on together!

Artisans - General Information

- **Event Date:** Saturday September 30, 2023
- Event Hours: 10:00 am to 2:30 pm.
- **Event Set Up:** set up begins at 8:30 am. Please note that there will be a lot of traffic (people and cars) so give yourself enough time to set up.
- Event Take Down: begins at 3:00 pm (no earlier).
- Requirement: we prefer that your art/craft be produced locally.
- Spaces: if you are providing your own tent and table, your tent size can be no larger than 10'x10' except with special permission. We will assign a space for you. If you are using a table provided by us, we will also assign you a space.
- Registration Fee: a registration fee of \$20.00 is required to reserve you spot.
- Special Requirements: if you have any requirements (e.g. access to electrical outlets) please indicate
 on your registration form so we can accommodate you.
- Tent Weights: new regulations require each tent have weights 20 lbs per leg.
- Parking: underground parking is available for a nominal cost.
